

Basketball is a sport that is a played on an indoor or outdoor court by two teams of five players. The object of the game is to score the most points by shooting a ball through a basket, or hoop.



Basketball was invented in Springfield, Massachusetts by a teacher by the name of James Naismith. At the school he was asked by the physical education teacher to invent a new indoor game, which could be played during the cold winter months in Massachusetts. He started working on the idea in December 1891. His ideas came from other sports he played as a child. Their favorite game "Duck on the Rock" involved one boy guarding the duck from the other boys throwing stones at the rock.

On December 21, 1891, Naismith tried his new game by using five base ideas and thirteen rules. That day he asked his class to play a game, nine versus nine, using a soccer ball and two peach baskets. Someone suggested calling the game "Naismith Game" because he was the inventor, but he suggested calling it "basket ball" because it involved a ball and basket. The peach baskets were closed so therefore the ball had to be retrieved manually by someone using a stair. Later they would cut a small hole in the peach baskets so someone could use a stick and poke the ball out. The soccer ball was replace by a Spalding ball, and in 1906, metal hoops, nets and boards were introduced. Also the players couldn't move; they had to just pass the ball, there was no dribbling.


