PURPOSE OF THIS SPECIFICATION:

This specification is to insure that both parties (homeowner and building contractor) know as much detail as possible about this building project so that conflicts and mis-understandings can be minimized. Many homeowners and building contractors enter into a verbal agreement only to find themselves in awkward and miss-trusting situations.

GENERAL:

All blank spaces in this specification that apply to this building are to be filled in. All blank spaces that do not apply are to be crossed out. The general conditions herein set forth shall apply to any contract given under this specification and shall be binding upon every sub-contractor as well as General contractor. The General contractor takes full responsibility for meeting all local and state codes for the construction of this project. The plans, elevations, sections and detail drawings, together with this specification, are to form the basis of the contract and are to be of equal force. Should anything be mentioned in this specification and not shown in the drawings, or vice versa, the same shall be followed as if set forth in both. It is the intent of this specification and accompanying drawings to correspond and to embody every item and part necessary for the completion of the structure. The contractor shall comply with all health and building ordinances that are applicable.

EXTRAS OR CREDITS:

Any deviation from this specification or drawing plans involving an extra charge or a credit must be agreed upon in writing between the contracting parties before the change is made. The contractor shall not take advantage of any discrepancies in the drawings and specification. If any discrepancies are found, they shall be referred to the owner and be corrected before any contract is entered into.

INSURANCE:

The contractor will provide liability insurance and workmen's compensation insurance in full until completion of the building. Fire and windstorm insurance during construction to be provided by owner.

EXCAVATION AND GRADING:

The contractor shall do all necessary excavating and rough grading. The excavation shall be large enough to permit inspection of footings after the foundation has been completed. All excess dirt shall be hauled away by the contractor. Black surface loam to be piled where directed by owner for use in grading. The finish grading shall be done by the owner. Grade level shall be established by the owner, who will also furnish a survey of the lot showing the location of the building. The finish grading, seeding, sodding, and landscaping shall be done by the owner unless specified as follows:

CONCRETE FOOTINGS:

Footings shall be of concrete mixed in the proportion of one part Portland Cement, parts clean, coarse, sharp sand and ______ parts of gravel or crushed rock. Concrete shall be machine mixed with clean water to the proper consistency, and shall he placed immediately after mixing. Footings shall be thoroughly protected with hay or straw in freezing weather. All footing shall be set below the frostline and rest on firm soil, and shall be flat and level. Footings shall be of sized per code. Ready mixed concrete if used shall be _______.

Drain tile shall be placed around the perimeter of the building and ran to the sump hole or other means of run off.

Hearth to be supported on concrete slab of size shown on plan. All flues shall be cleaned of mortar drippings and the chimney shall be capped with a concrete wash or concrete cap as shown on plans.
